## ABOUT UCB

At UCB, everything we do starts with a simple question: "How will this make a difference to the lives of people living with severe diseases?" We have a passionate, long-term commitment to discovering and developing innovative medicines that transform the lives of people living with severe diseases. We do that by connecting with patients and their families around the world living with the physical and social burdens of severe disease. Those connections offer new perspectives, drive innovation, and offer the hope of a new generation of therapies that are helping to transform lives.

With a team of approximately 7,500 employees and operations in more than 40 countries, we are a global biopharmaceutical company investing more than a quarter of our revenue in cutting-edge scientific research to meet unmet patient needs. Global headquarters are in Brussels, Belgium, with U.S. headquarters in Atlanta, Georgia. Additional U.S. UCB sites include global clinical development at our Research Triangle Park, North Carolina campus (UCB Biosciences, Inc.), and research supporting UCB's pipeline in Cambridge, Massachusetts. UCB also has a government relations and public policy office in Washington, D.C. and an innovation Solution Accelerator office on the Georgia Tech campus.

## IN THE U.S.

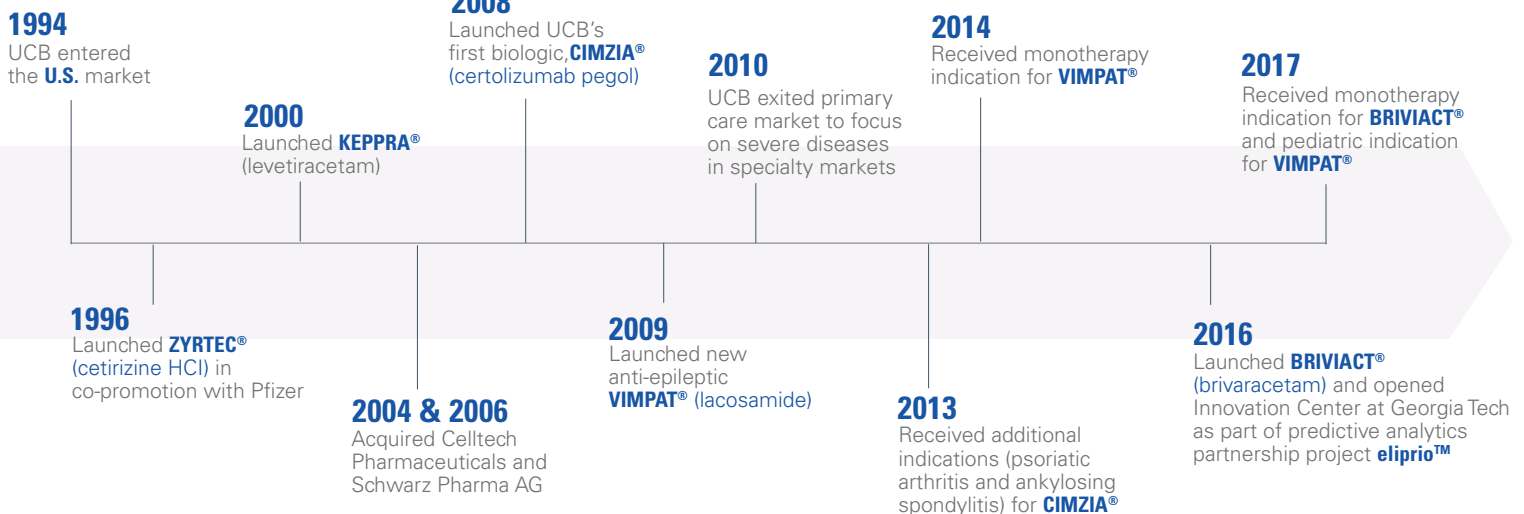
As UCB's largest affiliate in the world, we have around 1,150 U.S.-based employees including our Patient Value Units focused on neurology, immunology, and bone.



UCB has been in the Atlanta area since opening its U.S. headquarters in 1994. UCB is the largest biopharmaceutical company with a U.S. headquarters in the Atlanta area with around 350 full-time employees in Smyrna and our Solution Accelerator Office on the Georgia Tech campus. Approximately 550 employees across the country in the field also report into the Atlanta headquarters. UCB's economic footprint in Georgia is approximately \$183 million, derived from estimates of 2016 payroll contributions and vendor-related items including hired services, travel, transportation and distribution, and technology.



UCB's global clinical development is based at our Research Triangle Park office in Raleigh, North Carolina with around 250 full-time employees. UCB has maintained a presence in the Raleigh area since 2001. UCB's economic footprint in North Carolina in 2016 was approximately \$54 million dollars (derived from estimates of payroll contributions).
